

Coaches Code of Conduct



Coaches

Must consider the well-being and safety of all participants before the development of performance;

Need to develop an appropriate working relationship with players, based on mutual trust and respect;

Must make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part;

Shall promote the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play);

Will display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance at all times;

Shall follow all guidelines laid down by the National Governing Body and the club;

Will hold appropriate valid qualifications and insurance cover;

Shall never exert undue influence over players to obtain personal benefit or reward;

Must never condone rule violations, rough play or the use of prohibited substances;

Should encourage players to value their performances and not Just results;

Shall encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour;

Must treat everyone equally and sensitively regardless of their gender, race, ethnic origin, cultural background, sexual orientation, religious belief or political affiliation;

Will not use foul, sexist or racist language;

Use your official position to take action against spectators who harass, abuse or use foul, sexist or racist language towards players, match officials or coaches
